

We've also committed to making the Fringe more inclusive and accessible for all our artists and audience, with initiatives in this and the coming years to ensure everyone can (and does!) Fringe.

Our Twenty is Plenty donation campaign is also going strong, with a record number of patrons showing their support for Fringe with a monthly or one-time donation of \$20, in honour of our 20 years. Why not join them?

First Fringe?

STEP 1 Pick up your pin

Only \$3. A Fringe Pin is required to purchase a ticket. Since 100% of ticket sales are returned to the performers, pin sales help keep the Festival growing.

Pins are available online, at all box offices, and at every venue.

STEP 2

Buy your tickets

ONLINE until midnight the day before.

AT A BOX OFFICE up to one hour before showtime.

AT THE DOOR within one hour of showtime (cash only).

STEP 3

Hit the Beer Tent

Stop in for food and a drink, find out what to see, and meet new friends: the Beer Tent is Ottawa Fringe's hub, located on Tabaret Lawn on the UofO campus – just steps from Academic Hall, Studio Léonard-Beaulne, and a handful of BYOVs.
