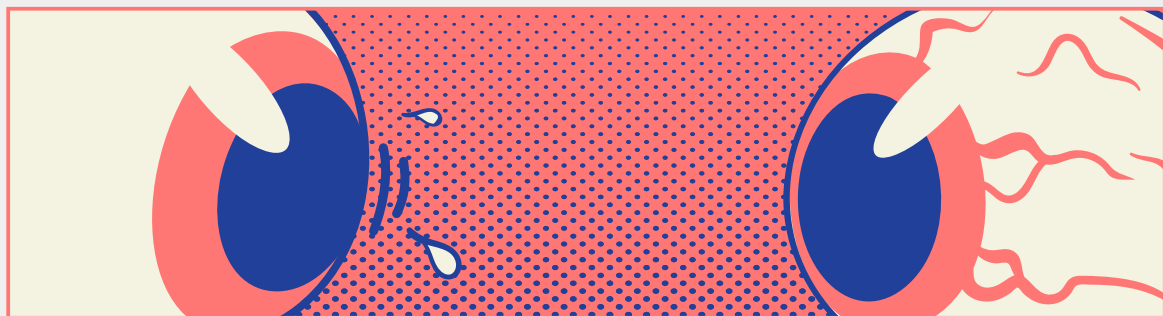
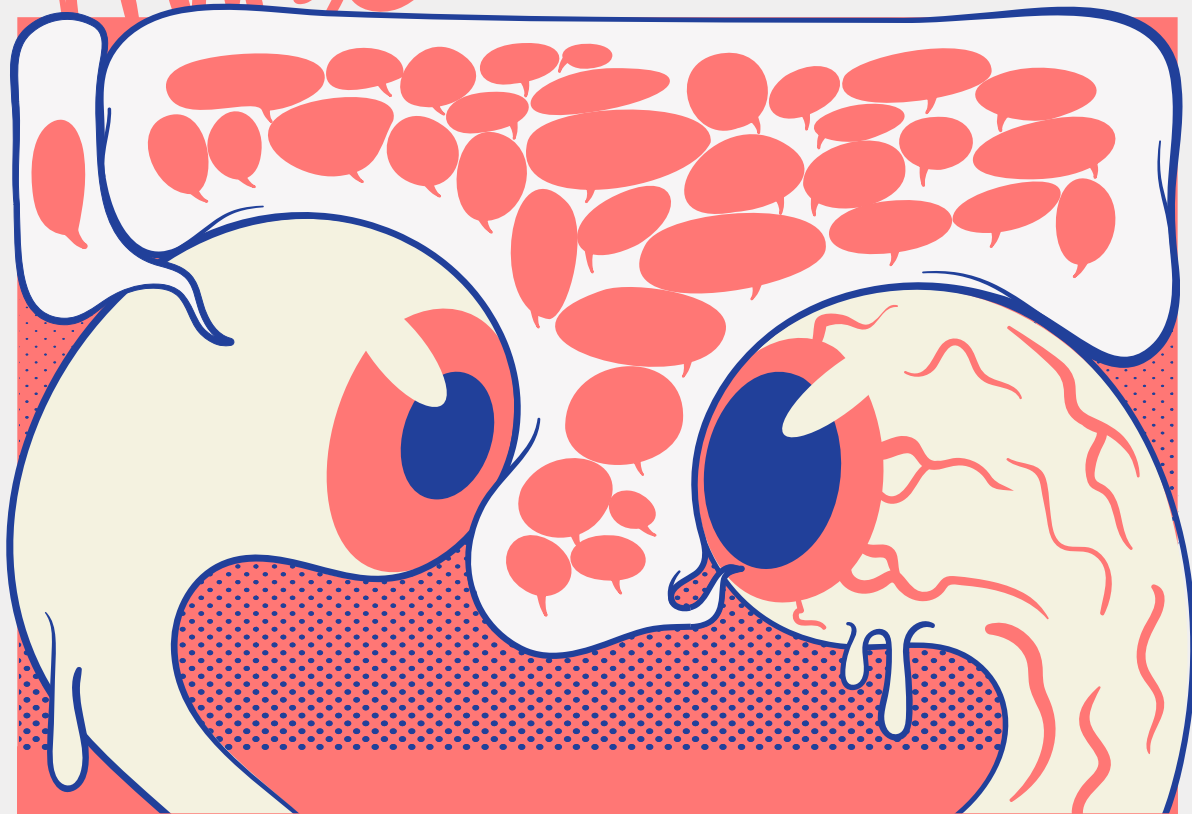

Director's Message

Welcome to the 2018 Ottawa Fringe Festival!

It's an exciting year for us – after years of construction the Arts Court redevelopment is finally complete, giving us a host of new (and revamped) venues and spaces to play. Stop by the Sky Lounge on the third floor of the Ottawa Art Gallery, where you can grab a drink and a snack, chat with friends, and enjoy a stunning view of the city; then take a stroll down the hall to purchase tickets from our brand new Box Office. We've renovated Arts Court Library and re-introduced it as a BYOV this year; and our friends from SAW Gallery have been kind enough to let us use their brand new Knot Project space.

We'll also be saying goodbye to some venues this year. We're happy to announce that as of 2019 all our spaces will be accessible. Bid a final farewell to Studio-Léonard Beaulne and any venue that requires climbing stairs for access. Fringe is for everyone, and now all of our audience will be able to see all of our shows.

This year I encourage you to overindulge. As Ottawa's largest theatre festival – presenting 57 shows in 10 venues over 11 days – the Fringe definitely has something for you.

Comedy? Check. Drama? Definitely. Musical? Many. Puppets? Plenty. Improv? Indeed. Circus? Certainly!

There's lots to see and little time – and you need to cram as much as you can into the next two weeks. Instead of spending that time in front of a screen, why not Binge on Fringe? Treat yourself to a show by one of your favourite artists, then take a risk on someone who could become a new favourite. Let your best friend decide what to see at 7:00 pm, then you choose what's on at 8:30. Come down to the festival every night, and sleep during the day. It might not be technically possible to see every show, but you can give it your best shot!

First Fringe?

STEP 1

Pick up your pin

Only \$3. Fringe Pins are required to purchase a ticket. Since 100% of ticket sales are returned to the performers, pin sales help keep the Festival growing.

Pins are available online, at the box office, and at all venues.

STEP 2

Buy your tickets

ONLINE or AT A BOX OFFICE up to two hours before showtime.

AT THE VENUE within one hour of showtime (cash only).

STEP 3

Visit the Fringe Sky Lounge

Enjoy a stunning view of the city, grab some food and drink, and meet new friends: the Sky Lounge is Ottawa Fringe's hub, located on the 3rd floor of the new Ottawa Art Gallery – just down the hall from Arts Court Theatre and the Festival Box Office.
