We rely on grants, members and donors to support this endeavour: a Festival with no curator and where 100% of ticket sales go to the artists.



The Ottawa Fringe is now officially **Rainbow Registered**. Companies and organizations who are Rainbow Registered must go through a thorough application and assessment process to determine if they meet the appropriate standards for this designation. Only \$3. Fringe Pins are required to purchase a ticket. Since 100% of ticket sales are returned to the performers, pin sales help keep the festival going.

New Access Initiative This Year!

We are excited to announce a new access initiative for this year's festival called "Listen Everywhere".

What is Listen Everywhere?

Listen Everywhere is an app that anyone can download for free and use in select venues during the festival. This app supports Assistive Listening for audiences who need the show's sounds to be amplified. Additionally this app allows for Audio Description*, which is where an Audio Describer describes the visuals of a show. To use the Listen Everywhere:

- 1. Download the app
- 2. Connect to your venue's wifi
- **3.** Plug in your earbuds
- **4.** Select your venue and channel either for Assistive Listening or Audio Description.
- 5. Sit back and enjoy the show!
