On closing night, five of the festival's top-selling shows will stage encore performances. These are Fringe fundraisers, with box office split 50/50 between the artist and the Festival.

Not only is the Fringe pin your key to getting into Festival shows, but since 100% of ticket revenue returns to artists, it serves as a fundraiser for the Fringe. Pins are only \$3 or you can get a legacy pin for \$12. Pretty cool, huh?

MONEY SAVING TIPS

Want to see a bunch of Fringe shows, but aren't sure which ones? Buy now and decide later! Fringe passes are a great way to buy bulk blank tickets at a discounted price!

There are two types of passes: **5 Show Passes** and **10 Show Passes**.

Passes can be purchased at the Arts Court Theatre and La Nouvelle Scène box offices or over the phone. Passes are not available online for purchase. More information can be found at ottawafringe.com/boxoffices

Many shows are offering HALF PRICE TICKETS.
These rush tickets are for select performances and are available day-of at the Festival Box Office. What shows and what dates? Keep your eyes on our

newsletter and social media.

LISTEN EVERYWHERE

This year we are bringing back our Listen Everywhere access initiative to ensure the comfort and enjoyment of our patrons who need enhanced audio!

What is Listen Everywhere?

Listen Everywhere is an app that anyone can download for free and use in select venues during the festival. This app supports Assistive Listening for audiences who need the show's sounds to be amplified. Additionally this app allows for Audio Description, which is where an Audio Describer describes the visuals of a show. To use the Listen Everywhere:

- 1. Download the app
- Connect to your venue's wifi
- 3. Plug in your earbuds
- Select your venue and channel either for Assistive Listening or Audio Description.
- 5. Sit back and enjoy the show!

No sweat, the box office will have a few on hand that you can borrow on a first-come-first-served basis.

Only \$3. Fringe Pins are required to purchase a ticket. Since 100% of ticket revenue are returned to the performers, pin sales help keep the festival going.
