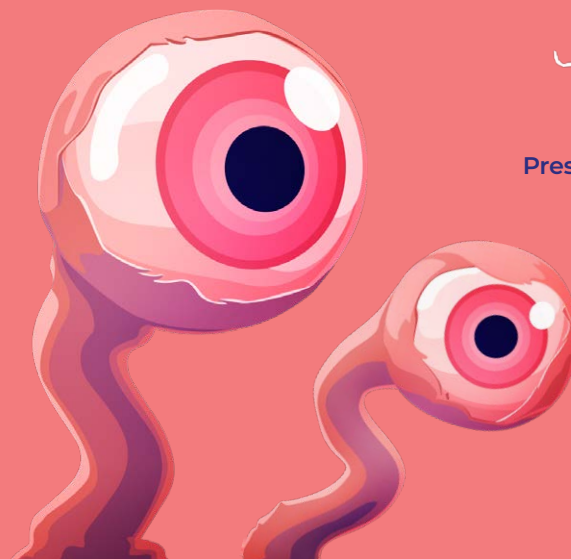

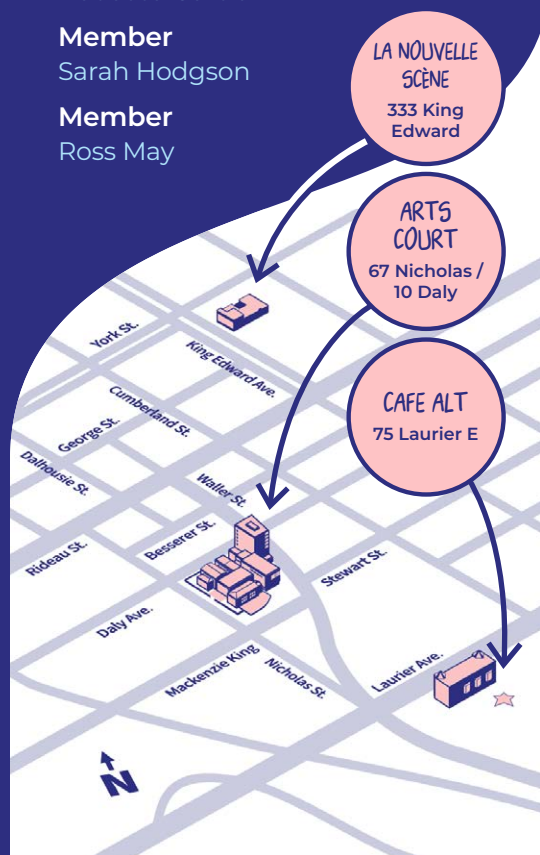

FRINGE FESTIVAL 2025

TICKETS AND BOX OFFICES

Single tickets: \$14 + service fees. All box offices are located around the festival grounds. They accept cash, credit and debit.

IN-PERSON:

All box offices will be open **June 12-22** one hour before the first performance of the day.

ONLINE:

Tickets are available online until showtime!

FESTIVAL BOX OFFICES:

- Fringe Courtyard (67 Nicholas St.)
- Arts Court Theatre (67 Nicholas St.)
- La Nouvelle Scène (333 King Edward Ave.)
- LabO Box office (Pop-up box office - high traffic times - 10 Daly Ave.)

Can't pick just one show? You don't have to.

Fringe Passes let you grab a bunch of tickets now and decide what to see later. It's like a choose-your-own-theatre-adventure, on a discount! Go for a **5-Show Pass** or double down with a **10-Show Pass**. Use them all yourself, share with a friend, or see the same show ten times (hey, we don't judge).
