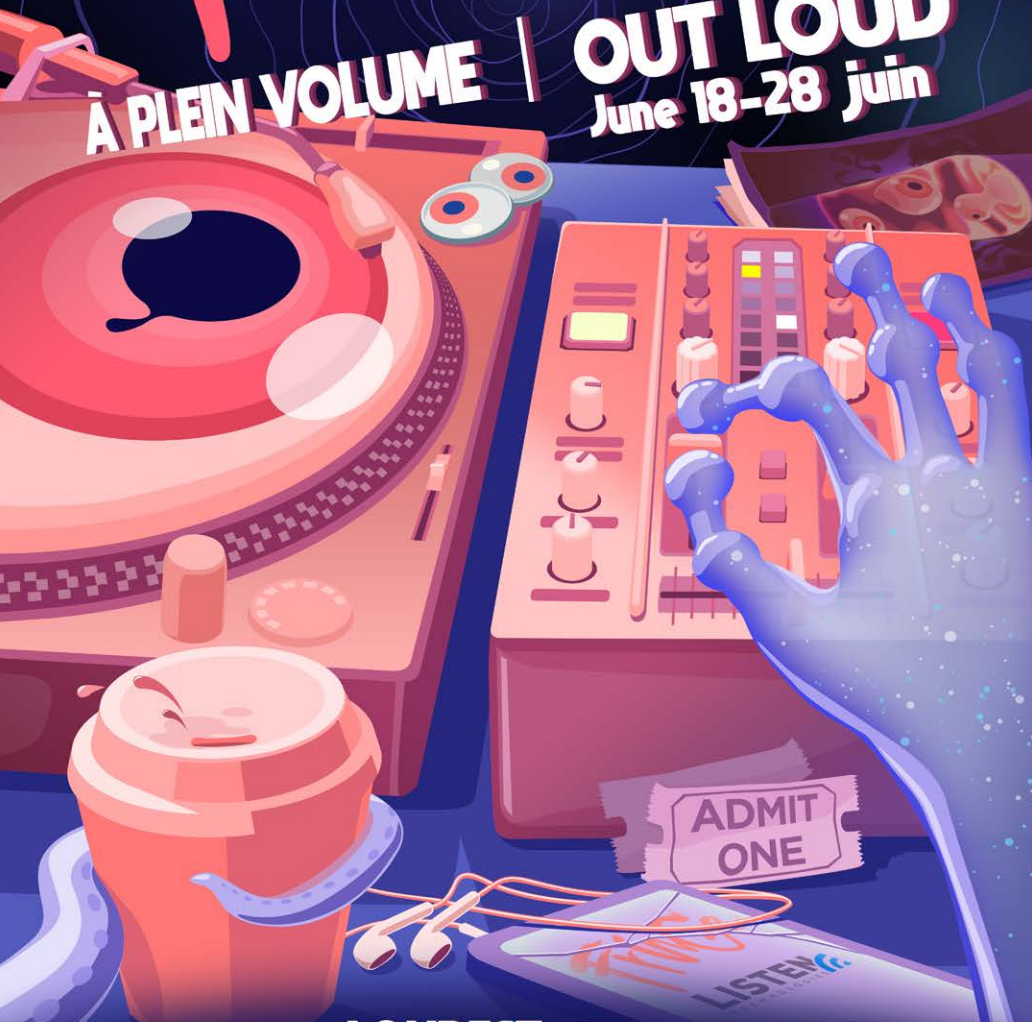

DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE / MESSAGE DU DIRECTEUR

Welcome to the 29th Ottawa Fringe Festival: Fringe Out Loud!

Bienvenue, welcome, et re-bienvenue à ce qui est officiellement notre plus LOUD Fringe à ce jour.

This year, we're bringing you 62 shows across 10 venues – quite possibly the most we've ever programmed in our history. That's 62 chances to stumble into something brilliant, strange, moving, hilarious, or all of the above at once. 62 raisons de dire "just one more show" encore et encore.

It's also our second year offering a dedicated Francophone category and expanding bilingual programming across the festival. We're proud to continue growing a space where artists can create and audiences can experience work in both official languages – sometimes in the same breath, parfois dans la même phrase.

We're also very happy to welcome back our Community Series at the Club SAW courtyard – un lieu de rencontre, de repos, de conversations imprévues, et parfois de décisions très spontanées de "okay, let's see another show."
